

***Academic Hearing Panel Report
September 1, 2004-August 31, 2005***

In accordance with article 69 of the Code of Conduct (Academic), this report is submitted to the September meeting of Senate and will be published in the University's newspaper.

There were a total 416 Incident Reports filed during the time period covered by this report. The specific breakdown and disposition of these reports, by faculty, may be found below in Table A.

Of the 265 charges already upheld at the faculty level, a total of 23 Academic Hearing Panels (AHPs) were held and another five (5) hearings are scheduled for September 2005. In addition, 20 AHPs that resulted from charges upheld during 2003-2004 were held during the period covered by this report.

There were three requests for permission to appeal decisions of an AHP filed during the year. Permission for an Appeal Panel was not granted in any of the cases.
